

Red Pack



**Age: 5 – 11
(Key Stages 1 & 2)**

These activities teach young children key vocabularies and cover a basic idea on identity while demonstrating how exclusion and bullying can hurt their friends and peers.

Blue Pack



**Age: 11 - 16
(Key Stages 3 & 4)**

These activities discuss issues such as discrimination, stereotyping, and race hate crime through role-playing and comparative charts. Identity is also explored, but on a more complex level.

Pink Pack



Age: 16-20

These activities are intended for young adults, focusing on the underlying causes of race hate crime, and debunking myths or stereotypes while demonstrating the consequences of discrimination.

Purple Pack



Age: 20+

These activities are aimed at adults, emphasising the responsibility each person has to check their assumptions. Diversity, identities, and power dynamics are also examined.
